



CVC-OEI Consortium: January 2019 Key Messages

CVC-OEI Update

- Governor Newsom released his proposed state budget and there is no reduction or increase to the CVC-OEI's ongoing funding allocation.
- Last year, the CVC-OEI received \$35 million in one-time funding to award grants to help colleges/districts to complete short-term projects that will improve access to online learning, fill gaps that meet workforce demands, and enhance support for faculty and students. The planning and development phase will take place between February - May 2019.
- Work continues on the CVC-OEI rebrand. 25th Hour Communications is currently in the creative development phase and will share preliminary brand concepts in mid-February.
- Product development is completed for the cross-enrollment project. Foothill-De Anza and Los Rios are in the User Acceptance Testing (UAT) phase; Cabrillo is preparing for UAT. The project has been branded ExCEL, which stands for Exchange Cross Enrollment Link.

Local Peer Online Course Review (POCR)

- The @ONE team is adding resources to the Local POCR site, including tips for getting review ready and suggested guidelines for faculty participation. Autumn Bell also reminded Project Leads to include their instructional designer in the review process.
- After a panel discussion featuring Project Leads who have successfully implemented a Local POCR, attendees broke into small groups to discuss strategies for implementing on their respective campus. Notes from that will be made available via Basecamp.

Ecosystem Canvas Shell

- A new Canvas shell featuring CVC-OEI ecosystem tools is currently under development. Included in the shell will be product overviews, "how to" tutorials, best practices, and testimonials.

Finish Faster Online

- A digital advertising campaign, focused on late start classes and underrepresented students in "higher education deserts," resulted in 500 completed applications to Consortium colleges. To date, 1,260 completed applications have been submitted to Consortium colleges through the online course finder.
- The CVC-OEI will again partner with CSU Online on a summer online course finder.

Cross Enrollment Admin Panel

- The cross-enrollment project includes an admin panel which allows Project Leads and other campus personnel to pull enrollment reports related to cross-enrollment. There are also features which allow student services personnel to perform administrative actions.

Implementation Teams: Next Steps

- Project Leads are encouraged to schedule regular implementation team meetings with their local teams. Kate Jordahl has suggested topics of discussion in her PowerPoint posted in Basecamp.
- Please also remember to share out important information from Consortium meetings with team members. You can also forward these talking points as a quick update.
- A spreadsheet detailing which colleges have implemented which ecosystem tools has been posted to Basecamp. Please contact Kate Jordahl for any updates or corrections.
- The CVC-OEI will discontinue funding for Vericite, effective June 30, 2019. If your college would like to continue using the product, the statewide library association has a pricing agreement.
